Nevada Women's Fund Awards \$241,670 in 2021

Empowering Our Future Leaders Today to be Ready for a Stronger Tomorrow

As we look to 40 years of service fulfilling our mission to uplift the lives of women and families, we are very proud to share that 2021 education scholarship distributions were the highest in our history. Eighty northern Nevada women were awarded \$218,330! These awards allow progress on women's goals for professional careers and higher earnings; while at the same time lifting our community through economic investments.

Economic investment? How? Because the Nevada Women's Fund student will become an electrical engineer, nurse, judge, teacher, social worker, marketing professional, public servant, entrepreneur, and so much more. She will buy a house and car here in Nevada and send her children to school and college here. She lives in our community, and pursues her professional goals in our community. Most importantly, she is prepared to go forward. She's empowered and ready, particularly after the economic and emotional impact of the global pandemic. Moving forward is vital to her and her future.

In addition to scholarships, Nevada Women's Fund donor directed funds helped sustain the services of needed community non-profits. Assistance League Reno-Sparks Operation School Bell, The Discovery-Terry Lee Wells Nevada Discovery Museum, Nevada Women's History Project, and the Women and Children's Center of the Sierra received funding grants totaling \$23,340.

All of this to say, the Nevada Women's Fund is strong and engaged and continues to stay on mission, as you ask. We too are ready for tomorrow!

President's Message



Celebrating Legacy: A Tribute to Those Who Had Vision, Passion and Commitment and Started A 40-Year Journey

Recently with donors and scholarship recipients, and in this newsletter, we celebrate the highest single year education scholarship distributions in NWF history. Frankly, I was not sure what the donor contributions would be as we entered year two of the global pandemic. But when donations continued and were increased by many, I knew it was because of the multiple years of commitment by the numerous women who dedicated hours of volunteer time through their board work and leadership. We would not be where we are today without the legacy of those at the helm in the beginning and over these many years.

All organizations benefit from solid footing and best practices. Our footing is in the legacy of Fritsi Ericson. She was a founding board member and early Executive Director of the Nevada Women's Fund, investing more than 20 years into our creation. She cultivated supporters to sustain the Nevada Women's Fund into the future. And then, another 20 years as the community ambassador of opportunities available at the NWF. Through her final days she reminded those interested in higher education to seek opportunities through the organization she assembled with her colleagues and friends. Fritsi is responsible for the formation of the NWF endowment that awards scholarships and grants in perpetuity. At June 30, 2021, the endowment is valued at \$3.5 million and we maintain an unrestricted reserve fund valued at \$1.2 million. Fritsi was the NWF historian and our community ambassador. She was my mentor and friend. Sadly, she passed away in July. I miss her.

However, I know it would make her happy to hear that for the 2021 scholarship cycle the minimum individual award was raised from \$1,500 to \$1,750 and the applications included women seeking Associate, Bachelors, Masters, and Doctorate degrees and want to be business leaders, nurses, medical professionals, psychologists, computer scientists and engineers.

We can do this because today, close to 40 years later, we stand on Fritsi's resilient shoulders and those of the more than 275 community women that have served the Board of Directors of the Nevada Women's Fund. Their *vision* for our future was with *passion* and *commitment*. In the days when one licked stamps and envelopes, they did so with their children at the kitchen table. They planned and serviced all events that would raise funding for the Nevada Women's Fund, that could then be distributed to women with *vision*, *passion* and *commitment*.

Thank you for all you do to empower women of our northern Nevada community. Today we celebrate the legacy of the remarkable women who established the Nevada Women's Fund with *vision*, *passion and commitment*.



Nevada Women's Fund 2021 Statistical Review


College Enrollment Status






