

Nevada Women's Fund is proud to announce that our 2023 education scholarship distributions surged by an impressive 30% over last year to \$420,000 awarded to 114 deserving women! These scholarships serve as a catalyst for women from northern Nevada to pursue their dreams of career advancement and higher earning potential while empowering families and playing a pivotal role in realizing Nevada Women's Fund's overarching mission of strengthen our community.

Each fall, we celebrate our scholarship recipients and donors on the pages of this newsletter, and in person at our scholarship reception hosted at the Eldorado, this year is no different, except for all the ways in which it is. In honor of our 40th year, we committed to raising and awarding \$400,000 in scholarship funding in 2023; with the generous support of individual and corporate donors, we exceeded that commitment and awarded 114 women with \$420,000 in academic scholarships – an increase of 30%! Nevada Women's Fund awards \$28,707 in grants to local non-profits

In August, NWF awarded \$25,000 to F.I.S.H. (Friends in Service Helping) to provide vital housing cost subsidies for women residing within the newly constructed F.I.S.H. Family Student Housing project in Carson City. This visionary initiative was crafted to afford women the invaluable chance to pursue their education devoid of the financial strain posed by housing expenses. By unlocking their economic potential through education, this endeavor not only empowers these women, but uplifts their families entrenched in generational poverty, thereby fostering the fortification of communities.



In addition, Nevada Women's Fund donors directed their generosity towards bolstering the efforts of two esteemed local nonprofit organizations through targeted grants. \$3,707 was allocated to the Nevada Women's History Project and the Terry Lee Wells Discovery Museum. This financial infusion stands as a testament to NWF's unwavering commitment to nurturing and sustaining the impactful work of these community-driven entities.
